Hanover Township Youth and Family Services (HTYFS) offers a unique clinical practice opportunity for students. The mission of the department is to combat juvenile delinquency, to strengthen families, provide outreach to children and teens, and to contribute to building a healthier community for residents.

For graduate level, second year students, the department serves residents of the Township via strength and resiliency based family therapy. Expectations of a second year student include providing a complete array of clinical services to families assigned, and to participate as a member of a collegial team. In addition, second year students are given opportunities to work in the community, in collaboration with the local schools and in our Open Gym After School Program.

For first year graduate students, or students in an undergraduate program, the department's prevention programming provides numerous educational opportunities. Some of these programs include: The Open Gym After School Program, The Alternative to Suspension Program, and various group work offered at schools.

The educational needs of the student are balanced with the need of the clients being served in determining tasks and opportunities offered to each student. Students are eligible for a stipend throughout the time they are with Hanover Township Youth and Family Services.
