Internship Highlights:

Internship Requirements:

- ❖ Summer reading assignments to be completed prior to starting the internship
- ❖ Availability during hours of 10 a.m. – 8 p.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays preferred
- ❖ Willingness and time to complete weekly reading assignments
- ❖ Ability to commit to the internship program from mid August through early July
- ❖ Flexibility to accept limited breaks of approximately two weeks in winter and one week in spring
